

**FOIPOP, July 13, 2018:**

These findings are presented in the order requested:

- As of July 13, 2018, the number of Stage 3+ pressure injuries reported to Dept. of Health from licensed Long Term Care facilities.
  - 144 injuries were reported by nursing homes
- As of July 13, 2018, the number of Stage 1 and Stage 2 pressure injuries reported.
  - 477 injuries were reported by nursing homes
- As of July 13, 2018, the prevalence rate for the total number of residents with pressure injuries: 7%
  - There is no prevalence rate specifically available for Stage 3 & 4 pressure injuries because the prevalence calculation is based on the total number of residents with pressure injuries. This information is not broken down by specific stage of pressure injury.
  - **Note:** One resident may have multiple injuries.
- By facility:
  - The following information is reported at the zone level, so as not to unduly single out individual facilities and encroach on the privacy rights of individual residents. This data is intended only to assist with identifying potential areas for sector support.
